Attendance

Late Arrivals

Watter bottles

Wide brimmed, legionaries or bucket hats must be worn from 15th August to 30th April. Generic hats can be worn as long as they are a sun smart style – no caps. In Term 4, the Year 2 students will get creative with paper mâché and other hands-on art projects. They'll design, build and decorate their own 3D artworks using paper, paint and plenty of imagination. Students will explore how artists use different materials and techniques to bring their ideas to life while having lots of messy, creative fun along the way.



Welcome to the final term for the year! In Bush we will be learning about flowers, why we have them, why we need them, and their parts. The children will construct their own flowers to add to a combined "Spring" wall display. What would spring be without insects? We will be adding a variety of bugs to our garden as well.

We will be joining the Great Aussie Bird count again this year, with all grades heading out with binoculars and checklists, just like real scientists. The results will be recorded on the national website, providing lots of data for our scientists about what birds live in each area.





This term in.....



In English this term, students will revisit narrative and persuasive writing. They will explore how to create engaging stories and use persuasive language to share their opinions. We look forward to seeing their creativity and growing confidence as writers!



In Core literacy this term, students will be learning about how words are built and what they mean by exploring prefixes and suffixes such as dis-, im-, -er and -able. They will see how these change word meanings and continue to practise reading with fluency and expression.



In Numeracy this term, students will build their understanding of multiplication by using number patterns and solving everyday problems. In statistics, they will collect, organise and interpret data to answer questions. As part of our space unit, students will explore position, direction and movement.



In Inquiry this term, students will design and build their own robots using craft materials. They will explore different materials and their uses, write clear instructions, and think about how robots and everyday objects are designed to meet different needs.
