# IMPORTANT REMINDERS



#### **Attendance**

#### **Sun Smart**



## Specialist programs

In PE this term, students will be refining and applying their skills in preparation for the House Athletics Carnival on 6
November 2025. Alongside athletics, students will engage in Minor Team Games that draw on skills from sports such as football, soccer, cricket and tennis. A continued focus will be placed on teamwork, fair play and demonstrating strong sportsmanship.





This term in Food, students will continue to develop their confidence and independence in the kitchen space. They will be making a variety of things including 'Choc zucchini muffins' and 'Cheese and spinach wontons'.









In Media Arts, year 5 students are planning and creating their own movie about a natural disaster of their choice. They can choose to make a scientific video, a news report or a story either fictional or factual. Working with a partner they are required to make everything they need for their animation, film it and add sound effects.





## EXPLORE

Students will working towards completing their presentations to a judging panel. For the 5's this will the presentation of their vertical garden.

#### This term in.....



In English this term, students will be reading War Horse, a text about World War 1. They will be studying themes from the text, learning new vocabulary and answering comprehension questions about the text. Students will write narrative texts based off different writing prompts. They will be practising improving their writing craft, through use of appositives, figurative language and careful vocabulary choices.



In Core Literacy this term, students will be practising spelling, vocabulary, grammar, handwriting and fluency.

They will look at vocabulary in different contexts, study synonyms and look at the words in sentences to decipher meaning. For spelling they will be studying long vs short vowel sounds as well as identifying spelling rules. In grammar they will be looking at parts of speech, learning about nouns, adjectives and verbs.



In Numeracy this term, students are starting off with operations. Students will do extensive Daily Review, studying topics previously taught this term so they can be ready for assessment. They will be looking at problems and studying the language to figure out which operation they need to use to solve the problem. They will be taught an array of strategies to solve each operation. They will study statistics, time and fractions to finish off the year.



In Inquiry this term, students are exploring inventions and the design process. They begin the term by researching famous Australian inventors and their inventions and writing information reports about the inventions. They will then explore other inventions through the design process, conducting experiments and using critical thinking to examine the process.
